Directions to Providence College Feinstein Center

From West: I-195 West to I-95 North. Follow directions from South.

From South: I-95 North to Exit 23 (State Offices) .Take right onto Orms St. Proceed straight for 0.3 miles to 2nd traffic light at Smith St (Rte 44). Turn right onto Smith St. proceed .7miles to Huxley Avenue (on right). Turn right onto Huxley Ave and cross Eaton St. The entrance to the campus will be on your left.

From North using Rte 146: Follow 146 South to Admiral St exit. Take a right onto Admiral St and proceed approx. .9 miles through two traffic lights to Huxley Ave (on left). Turn left on to Huxley Ave, and the entrance to the campus will be on your right.

From North using I-95: Follow I-95 South to Exit 23 (Charles St). Proceed right onto Charles St and go 0.2 miles to the 1st light. Take a left onto Admiral St and proceed approx. .9 miles through two traffic lights to Huxley Ave (on left). Turn left on to Huxley Ave, and the entrance to the campus will be on your right.
